## **Annual Dues and Expenses:**

2002 annual dues are paid through 3/31/2003. **97% of the 2002 annual dues and unpaid dues from previous years have been collected.** Prior to 2002, the best collection rate was 80%.

The 2003 invoice is similar to the way property taxes are billed. There is a discount for paying early and penalties/interest charged for paying after April 30. The Board of Directors approved a dues increase of \$15 per year - only \$10 if you pay early. Since the creation of the BHHCA, there has never been an increase in the annual dues. However, expenses have continued to rise year after year.

Our LG&E bill has increased about 13.5% per year and 41% since 2000. It's now approximately \$730 per month. Mailing and supply costs have increased. We have a permanent box/address at Mailboxes, Etc. and a website for better communication. The ditches and bridge areas were cleaned up and there will be attorney fees for the Declaration revisions. We recently learned that federal and state tax returns had not been filed in previous years and we were duty bound to correct it. Therefore, we hired a CPA to prepare the required returns. The CPA cost \$400 and we paid \$210 in fees to the state. We are hopeful there will be no further penalties for the federal returns.

The new entrance signs are a major improvement and enhance the value of our homes. The new signs WERE NOT a reason for increasing the annual dues because that cost was already factored into the existing debts. The monthly payments are fixed and the loan for the signs will be paid off in 5 years or less.

### **No Street Parking:**
